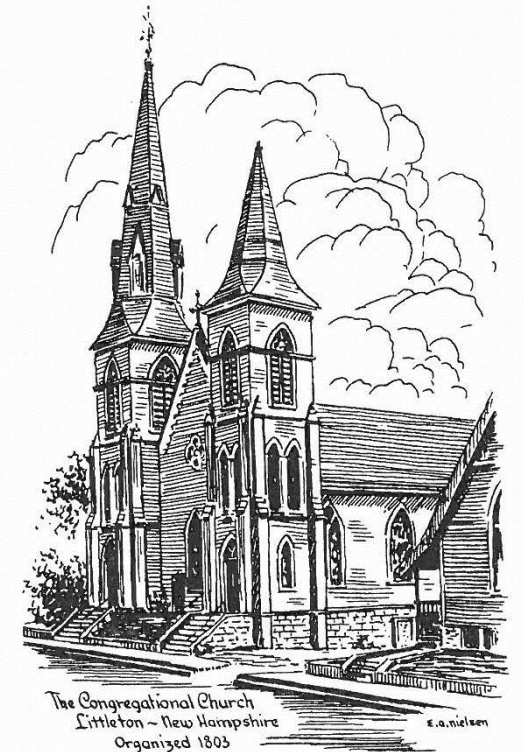

Sunday, March 15 marks our *One Great Hour of Sharing* special offering ~ the U.C.C. refugee, relief and development offering which helps transform lives through health, educational, agricultural and emergency relief initiatives in 138 countries around the world. Our generosity helps people worldwide to achieve self-sufficiency, to reach their full potential, to lead lives of dignity, and to reach some level of comfort and freedom from want and fear. For the past 66 years, *One Great Hour of Sharing* has been a multi-denominational effort with millions of Christians from diverse backgrounds joining forces on one day each year to reach out to those around the world. The theme chosen by the U.C.C. for this year’s OGHS campaign is drawn from 2 Corinthians 8:13-15: ***“Our desire is not that others might be relieved while you are hard pressed, but that there might be equality. At the present time your plenty will supply what they need, so that in turn their plenty will supply what you need. The goal is equality, as it is written: ‘The one who gathered much did not have too much, and the one who gathered little did not have too little’”***. In 2013 and 2014, our members and friends donated \$1,877.60 and \$1,987.00 respectively in support of *One Great Hour of Sharing*, more than double the amount raised in 2012. Please give generously, carrying forward our congregation’s rich tradition of serving those most in need.
